

SUPER SYSTEMS NCO-2H OVEN

General Information

Unpacking and Set up

The NCO-2H is shipped in heavy duty corrugated cardboard cartons. Inspect the carton and the equipment for any damage that may have occurred in shipping. Notify the delivery carrier if damage is discovered before or after unpacking the unit. It is your responsibility to file any freight claim.

Assembly

The NCO-2H oven comes completely assembled with the exception of the two wire bake racks. Place one wire rack over each set of elements in the oven. The bent side of the rack should be toward the front of the oven pointing down.

Electrical Requirements

The NCO-2H oven operates on a 120 volt 15 amp circuit. A separate circuit is recommended.

Oven Operation

Turn power switch to the "on" position (switch will illuminate). Set the thermostat at 375 degrees. Allow 15 minutes for oven to pre-heat. Set the reminder timer for appropriate setting. The buzzer will sound when time has elapsed. Turn the knob to the left to silence the buzzer. or 1/2 Hr.

NOTE: Due not obstruct oven vent!

Cleaning And Maintenance

The interior should swept clean of crumbs daily. Spillage should be removed to prevent burning and smoking in the unit. The wire bake racks, oven interior and glass door should be cleaned with a strong detergent and hot water. Oven cleaner (Part #905002) and Glass cleaner (Part #905003) can be ordered from the Super Systems Service department. The exterior of oven can be wiped clean with lemon oil to maintain a shiny surface. Door hinges and magnet can be adjusted so the door and gasket are allowed to seal properly.

WARNING! DO NOT USE ACID BASE CLEANERS! USE ONLY CLEANERS SUITABLE FOR USE ON ALUMINUM.

Warranty

Super Systems warrants to each original end-user that the equipment is free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of twelve months from date equipment was shipped from the factory. The purchaser is responsible for having the equipment properly installed, operated under normal conditions with proper supervision and have periodic preventative maintenance.
